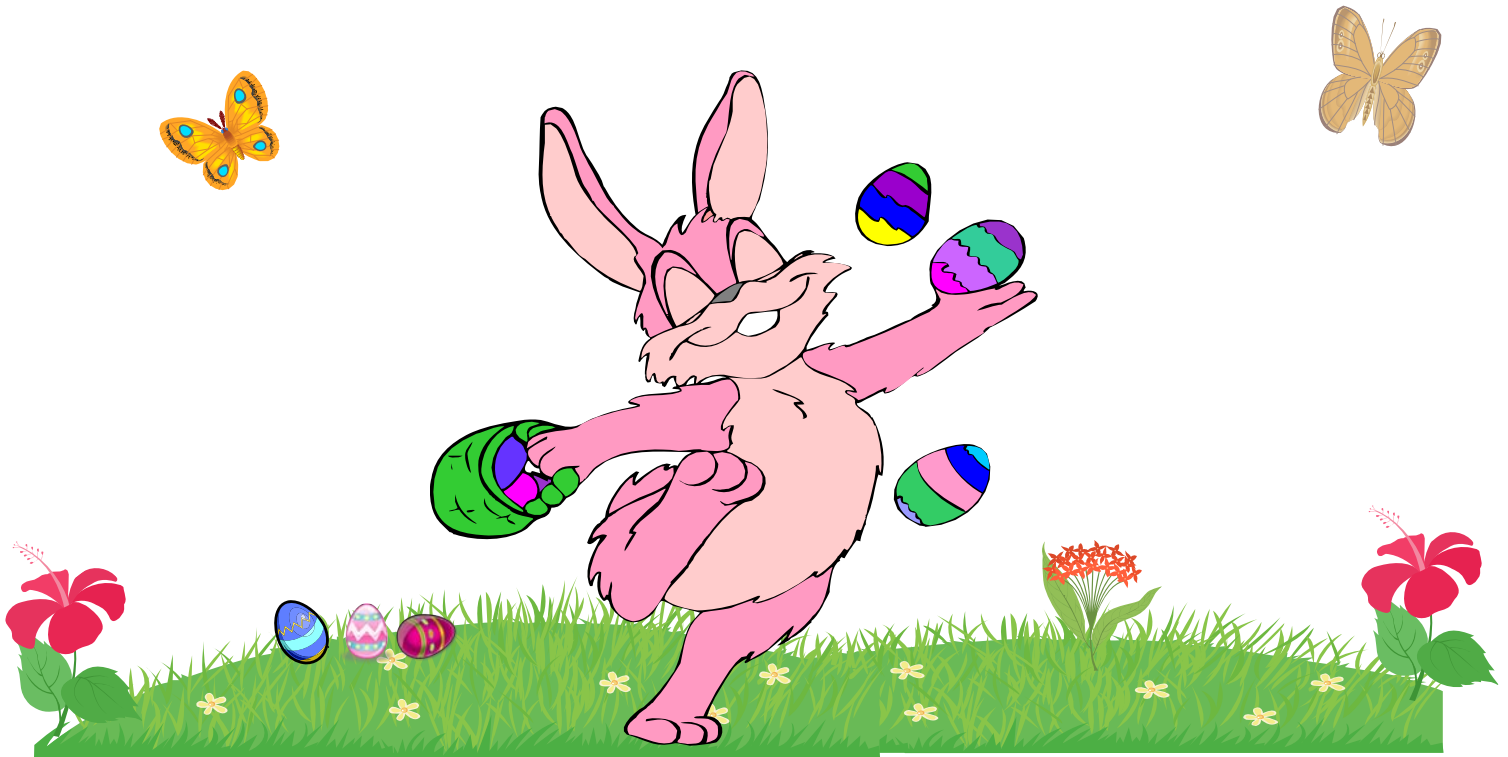

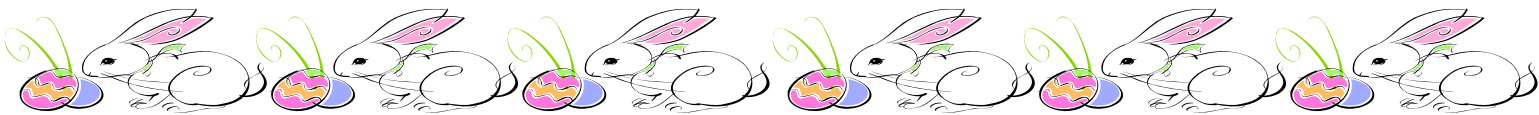

SENIOR MEAL GUIDELINES AND RESERVATION PROCEDURES

Meal Eligibility

1. Group dining meals are available to persons age 60 or more, and their spouses regardless of age, when the older person accompanies the spouse to the Center. Group dining meals are also available to disabled persons under age 60 who live with persons over age 60 and who are accompanied by the older person to the Center.
2. Meals are usually not ordered for persons under age 60; however, after all seniors have been served, persons under age 60 may purchase an un-served meal at the current charge of \$3.75. The Intervale Director may allow certain exceptions to this rule.
3. The suggested donation for eligible seniors is \$2.00.

Meal Reservations and Cancellations


1. Meal reservations should be made at least ONE DAY in advance.
2. Meal reservations will be accepted from 9:30 AM to 12 Noon and from 12:30 PM to 12:45 PM weekdays. It is recommended that all reservations be made in person since phone messages can be misplaced.
3. Meal cancellations or reservations for the NEXT DAY will be accepted until 12:45 PM since we must place our final meal order at that time. Seniors who have not canceled by 12:45 PM for the next day will be expected to honor their meal reservation. Those who continually do not honor their meal reservations may be placed on a waiting list rather than be given a spot on the reservation list.
4. **Meal reservations will be held until 11:45 AM. After 11:45 AM all available meals will be offered first to seniors on the waiting list and then to non-seniors. Serving time is 12 Noon.**
5. The meal reservation system is used as a guide in ordering meals. It is important to know that making a reservation does not guarantee a meal since "no-shows", shortages, non-deliveries, and other situations beyond our control may occur. In addition, if we see that meals are ordered for "no-shows" we will have no choice but to under-order meals in order to limit wastage. Therefore, you should honor your reservation, sign in for your meal and get your meal ticket as soon as you arrive at the Senior Center. Our goal is to provide a hot, tasty, nutritious noon meal for any senior who wishes to attend our program. To do this, we must be cost-conscious and maintain an efficient meal-ordering system because eventually "wasted meals" will lower the number of meals we can serve to the seniors who want them.




